The Deficit Findings of the CSRP Tool and next steps:

- The Village needs to evaluate and plan for costs associated with natural disasters especially flooding
- Increased community engagement and preparation around disasters
- More robust integration of municipal plans into government operations
- Creation of a long-term recovery plan for disasters
- Utilization of the Hazard Mitigation Plan in long term planning

The finding will be presented to the Sustainability Committee and a plan developed to address the findings will be drafted and presented to the Village Board of Trustees.
