The 2008 National Defense Authorization Act established the U.S. Vietnam War Commemoration to honor Vietnam War Era Veterans — Congressman Langworthy is authorized to present these veterans with the official commemorative lapel pin to thank them for their service to our country.

Eligibility: Living U.S. veterans who served on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces at any time during the period of November 1, 1955, to May 15, 1975, regardless of where they were stationed are eligible to receive a lapel pin. You do not need to live in the county where the ceremony wibe held.
